Franklin Township ONLY – Expansion of Board of Supervisors

QUESTION: Should two additional supervisors be elected to serve this township? Yes No

Plain English Statement:

This question asks voters of Franklin Township to determine if they wish to expand their board of supervisors from three members as currently constituted to five members, as is permitted by township code.

If a majority of voters choose YES as their option, two additional supervisors will be elected at the 2025 municipal election, with one supervisor serving for a term of four years and one for a term of six years, joining the current membership of three.

If a majority of voters choose NO, the board of supervisors will remain with three members and will remain on the same election cycle of one supervisor per municipal election appearing on the ballot. In no event shall this question be voted on more than once in any three-year period.
