

Caregiver Support Program



Are you the primary caregiver of a child under the age of 18?

Pre-approved caregiving expenses reimbursed

Benefits may include:

- Reimbursement of qualified caregiving expenses
- Access to Support Groups and counseling
- Benefits counseling
- Financial reimbursement for home modifications or assistive devices
- Respite care and babysitting so you can take a break from caregiving
- Reimbursement for qualified child enrichment programs— i.e. day-camps, musical instrument rentals, winter coats, school supplies.



For Grandparents raising grandchildren



For Caregivers of older adults

Financial verification required and total household income determines the percentage of monthly reimbursement.

- Caregiver is: An individual age 55 and older,
- Not the biological parent of the child(ren)
- Related by blood, marriage, or adoption or
- Has legal guardianship, or is raising the child(ren) informally

Care Receiver is: A dependent child under age 18

(The caregiver and care receiver must live in the same residence)
