Defendant shall petition the Court of Common Pleas of Beaver County for the return of confiscated weapons upon expiration and/or dismissal of a Protection from Abuse (PFA) Order.

Defendant shall complete and present to the Court a form titled, "Motion for Return of Property" available through the Beaver County Sheriff's Office. The Beaver County Sheriff's Office will be responsible for conducting a background check with the Pennsylvania State Police at the request of the Defendant prior to presentation of the Motion to the Court. The Beaver County Sheriff's Office will only sign and clock a Motion for Return of Property form when Defendant is approved by the Pennsylvania State Police. Any denial by a Pennsylvania State Police background check should be appealed to the Pennsylvania State Police within 30 days of the denial. Defendant shall attach to the Motion a copy of the Protection from Abuse Order indicating the expiration date having passed or attach the dismissal of the Protection from Abuse Order.

Defendant's Motion for Return of Property shall be presented during Motions Court to the

Judge who signed the Protection from Abuse Order. If that Judge is not holding weekly Motions for the
calendar year, Defendant shall contact Court Administration prior to presentation. Motions Court
practice schedule shall be defined by the court calendar of the year in which the motion is to be
presented.
